

PRIVACY POLICY PURSUANT TO ART. 13 OF LAW DECREE 196/2003

of having been informed regarding the purposes and methods of the processing of his/her personal data and more specifically of having been informed that:

1. said data will be used to meet the requirements to activate and manage administratively and accounting-wise the "Francesco Castelli International Award" as well as to promote and enhance the value of the Alessandro Rigi Luperti Foundation's institutional activities.
2. the processing will be performed through paper-based and/or electronic means;
3. the provision of personal data is mandatory. Refusal to provide the data will lead to the impossibility of participating to the "Francesco Castelli International Award";
4. the data provided will be processed exclusively by personnel appointed by the A.R.L. Foundation and/or companies or agencies specifically delegated by it;
5. the Data Controller is the Alessandro Rigi Luperti Foundation, Via Po 48/B, 00198 Rome.

At any time, you may exercise your rights towards the Data Controller, in accordance with Article 7 of Legislative Decree 196/2003 which is reported in full below:

"The Data Subject has the right to obtain confirmation of the existence of personal data concerning him/her, even if not yet recorded, and their communication in intelligible form. Furthermore, the Data Subject has the right to obtain information on:

- a) the origin of the personal data;
- b) the purposes and methods of the processing;
- c) the logic applied in the case of processing performed with the support of electronic means;
- d) the identifying details of the Data Controller, Data Protection Officer and Person in Charge of the data processing according to article 5, paragraph 2;
- e) the subjects or categories of subjects to whom the personal data may be communicated or that may become known to them in the role of Person in Charge of the processing in the territory of the State, Data Protection Officers or agents.

3. The Data Subject has the right to obtain:

- a) the updating, rectification or, when interested, the integration of his/her personal data;
- b) the erasure, transformation into anonymous form or blocking of the data unlawfully processed, including data stored but not necessary for the purposes for which the data were collected or subsequently processed;
- c) the certification that the operations referred to in letters a) and b) have been brought to the attention, also in terms of their contents, of those to whom the data have been communicated or disseminated, except in the case where this fulfillment proves to be impossible or involves the use of means manifestly disproportionate respect to the right being protected.

4. The Data Subject has the right to object, in whole or in part to:

- a) on the basis of legitimate grounds, the processing of personal data concerning him/her, even though they are relevant to the purpose of the collection;
- b) the processing of personal data concerning him/her for the purpose of sending advertising or direct sales material or for carrying out market research or commercial communications."
